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**Minimum Credit Requirements**  
In view of the Melville Comprehensive School philosophy that encourages students to explore a broad and diversified range of disciplines, all students are encouraged to take a minimum of **five** credits per semester. Grade 10 students **must** carry **five** credits per semester, while Grade 11 students must carry a total of **nine** credits, with no fewer than four per semester. Grade 12 students must carry a total of **eight** credits with no fewer than three per semester. **To graduate Grade 12, a student must have 24 credits, and five of these credits must be at a Grade 12 level (TWO English classes, ONE Social Studies, and TWO others/electives).** To be eligible for Grade 12 Melville Comprehensive School Scholarships, Grade 12 students must be enrolled in a total of 8 classes.  
**NEW for 2025-2026:** All music credits are offered outside of the regularly scheduled school day. As such, students who choose music electives may be permitted to carry more than the recommended number of credits.
